Refunds: No cash refunds will be made in the event of cancellation for any reason. Transfer of credits will be done on a weekly basis only and not for daily absences. Any child who, after a parent conference, continues to be unwilling or unable to comply with the rules of the camp will not be allowed to continue. No refund will be given.
